 - Lawn Mowers – 4-H Members age 9* & up are eligible to compete. 4-H Members will be required to drive and back through an obstacle course.
 - Tractors – 4-H Members 12* & up are eligible to compete. Junior members (age 12-13) will be required to back a 2-wheel trailer. Senior members (age 14-18) will be required to back a 2-wheel trailer and 4-wheel wagon.
 - Age by January 1, 2018. Contact the Extension Office by July 24th to register. Winners advance to the State Fair in August.

- Deadline for 4-H members to register their winning project from County Communication Night for the State Fair. If your project qualified for the State Fair, you'll receive more information in the mail in July.

Sunday, August 5th

- **Carter County Fair Exhibit Drop Off** - All 4-H members can enter their projects in the County Fair. Projects should be dropped off in the exhibit hall trailer at the fairgrounds on from 2:30-5:00. Livestock Exhibitors can turn in their project books during this time as well. For a complete list of 4-H projects that can be entered in the fair visit the Carter County 4-H website. Fair-goers can check out the exhibits nightly while at the fair.
